In his newsletter from Creighton University, Ernie Goss shows a strong upward trend for the Mid-America area:

February survey results at a glance:

- Leading economic indicator climbs to highest level in almost 3 years.
- For the first time since July 2007, we recorded job gains for two straight months.
- Almost 30% of supply managers expect prices to increase by more than 5% in the next six months. Less than 2% expect prices to decline.
- Inventories expanded for the first time in September 2008.
